

A List of Messianic Prophecies of the Hebrew Bible

Descent of the Messiah

- Genesis 3:15 from Eve
- Genesis 22:18 from Abraham
- Isa. 11:1; 2 Sam. 7:12-13; Ps. 132:11; Jer. 23:5-6; 33:15-17 from David

Birth of the Messiah

- Isaiah 9:6-7 born as a male child
- Isaiah 7:14 born of a virgin (LXX parthenos)
- Micah 5:2 in Bethlehem
- Numbers 24:17 a star appears
- Hosea 11:1 called out of Egypt

Roles of the Messiah

- Deuteronomy 18:15 a prophet like Moses
- Zech. 6:12-13; Ps. 110:4; Gen. 14 the Messiah is a king, and a priest after the order of Melchizedek
- Jeremiah 23:5-6 a righteous king like David
- Ps. 2:2 Messiah (Christ), the Anointed One
- Ps. 2:9; Num. 24:17; Ps. 110:2 has a sceptre/rod to strike down the nations
- Haggai 2:6-7 the Desire of all Nations, make the 2nd temple more glorious than the 1st
- Psalm 40:6-8 the new once for all sacrifice for sin
- Isaiah 53:10 a guilt offering for sinners
- Isaiah 40:11 a good Shepherd
- Daniel 7:13 the Son of Man
- Isaiah 42:1; 52:13 God's Servant

Divinity of the Messiah

- Psalm 2:7; 2 Samuel 7:12-14 God's Son
- Psalm 45:6-7 He is God, and as the Messiah has a sceptre
- Timing, when the Messiah would appear and die according to the Book of Daniel
- Daniel 9:24-27 begins his ministry 69 weeks after the decree to rebuild Jerusalem; is cut off in the middle of the 70th or last week of the prophecy (457 BC -> AD 27, AD 31). See my book, <http://www.exploringtheheavenlysanctuary.co.uk/> for more details.

Ministry of the Messiah

- Malachi 3:1-3 suddenly comes to his temple
- Isaiah 9:1-2; Isa. 49:6 brings light to the nations
- Genesis 22:18 a blessing to all nations
- Isaiah 53:4; 61:1-2 heals the sick; sets free the oppressed
- Isaiah 42:7 opens the eyes of the blind
- Psalm 78:2 taught in parables
- Zech. 9:9; Isa. 62:11 the king comes on a donkey with salvation
- Jeremiah 33:16 brings salvation
- Psalm 69:9 zeal for God's house
- Isaiah 11:2; 42:1; 61:1 has the Spirit of God upon Him

Death and Suffering of the Messiah

- Zechariah 11:12 betrayed for 30 pieces of silver
- Psalm 22:16 pierced in His hands and feet
- Isaiah 53:7 the Lamb of God
- Zech. 11:13 (Jer. 18:2-12; 19:1-15; 32:6-9) potters field purchased
- Psalm 22:16-18 garments gambled for
- Psalm 69:20-21 given vinegar to drink
- Isaiah 53:12 numbered with the transgressors
- Zechariah 12:10 pierced
- Psalm 41:9 betrayed by one who had eaten bread with Him
- Psalm 22:18 cast lots for His garments
- Exodus 12:46 no bones broken
- Isaiah 53:3-6 bore our sins; by His stripes we are healed
- Zechariah 13:7 Shepherd smitten, sheep scattered (arrested in the Garden of Gethsemane)
- Isaiah 50:6 spat upon
- Psalm 41:9 betrayed by one who ate with Him

Resurrection of the Messiah

- Psalm 16:10 resurrection - holy one not abandoned to the grave, nor see decay
- Psalm 110:1 at right hand of God
- Leviticus 23:11 raised on the third day, the firstfruits of the resurrection

Character of the Messiah

- Isaiah 42:1-4 gentle
- Isaiah 53:7 suffered silently for sinners
- Isaiah 53:9 sinless

Rejection of the Messiah

- Isaiah 6:9-10 people would not believe
- Isaiah 53:1 who has believed the report
- Isa. 53:3; Psalm 22:6 despised and rejected
- Ps. 118:22-23; Isa. 28:16; Dan. 2:44-45 the rejected stone which became the cornerstone

Pre-existence of the Messiah

- Psalm 110:1 David calls his son Lord

The Messianic Kingdom

- 2 Samuel 7:12; Daniel 7:13-14 an eternal kingdom
- Isaiah 11:6-9 no more suffering or cruelty
- Daniel 12:1-3 end of death, eternal life for the righteous
