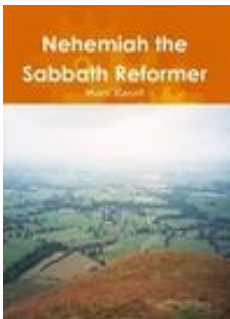


A new book about the investigative judgement had been released, “The Investigative Judgement: Am I Saved?”

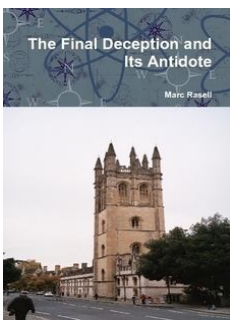
